Clarinet, saxophone, guitar and double bass interact in a way that exhibits a precise harmony of delicate sounds and sometimes exciting melodies. A little about the musicians behind the instruments mentioned: the saxophonist, clarinetist, composer and arranger Franz Oberthaler, known for his versatility and musical ability, has already celebrated many successes with the Vila Madalena duo. On the guitar, the virtuous, coming from the northeast of Brazil and musically comes from the Latin American tradition and jazz, Marco Antônio da Costa. The bass is provided by the Serbian bassist Jovan Torbica, whose musical versatility serves as the basis for a wide variety of bands and famous formations such as the “Wiener Tschuschenkapelle” or “DelaDap”.

The three musicians are very distinctive and multi-talented and when they play together, music is characterized by their contagious joy of playing, blending their interpretations to an unmistakable unity.
